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Belinda here, artisan soap maker and creator of the Soap Shaper™ design tools. Thanks for your purchase. I hope you enjoy using them as much as I do!

Here are some tips to help you get started:

- Attach the Soap Shaper to the threaded section of the stainless steel stem using 2 of the stainless steel screws provided; one on each side of the Soap Shaper, and tighten. Pictures and details can be found in the product page on the Soap Shaper Shop: bit.ly/2mWC7Pc. A video showing these steps is coming soon too.
- For best results work with a slow-moving cold process soap recipe, at a light to light/medium trace and at least 2 colours in alternating pours.
- A funnel can be used to help centre each pour. Simply place the funnel over the stainless steel stem so that it is poking up through the funnel. The stem will play a part in helping guide the soap batter towards the centre as you pour. The aim is not to break through the layers, and to allow each layer to sit on top of previous layers. You can achieve this best when you do a greater number of smaller pours. This is my go-to method and I count to 2 with each pour to help maintain consistent pour amounts.
- Squeeze bottles can also be used to pour each layer. You can take things one step further by adapting a pipette (e.g. amzn.to/371e8Rs) as an extension to the squeeze bottle tip. Simply remove the larger squeeze end of the pipette with scissors and affix the pipette over the squeeze bottle tip. Use tape to create an airtight seal. The longer tip will allow you to pour closer to the soap surface which will minimize the chance any pours breaking through

the soap surface, especially when you first start pouring. It may also help with centring each pour.

- Be sure not to fill the mold too high. The stainless steel stem should still be visible – it is your handle.
- Once you have finished pouring, gently and slowly, lift the Soap Shaper up through the mold using the stainless steel rod.
